

BREAKNDISH **CLUB RULES**

Membership

Membership is open to any person over the age of eighteen.

Anyone wishing to join the club must complete a Membership Form and return it with one year's subscription.

In the event of an application being refused any fees submitted will be returned.

Subscriptions shall be due on the 1st May each year. If any member fails to pay their subscription within one calendar month, they shall cease to be members.

If asked, applicants will be required to provide proof of age in the form of either a current passport or driving licence.

Members will be required to present their membership card on request of management or staff.

Guests

Any member may introduce guests to the club. Members must complete the guest book and a charge of £1.00 per guest will apply. No member may introduce more than two guests at one time. Any person who has been declined membership cannot be introduced. Members are responsible for their guests and their conduct during the period of their stay.

No charge will apply to members, officials and supporters of any team visiting the club for the purpose of playing an official fixture.

Under Eighteens

Anyone under the age of eighteen may be introduced to the club as a guest by any member. Normal guest rules apply but no charge will be made. It is an offence to supply alcohol to anyone under the age of eighteen.

Conduct

Excessive drunkenness, foul or abusive language, aggressive behaviour or any other inappropriate conduct will not be tolerated. Violent conduct or wilful damage to club property will result in expulsion from the club as will any attempt to supply alcohol to anyone under the age of eighteen. Anyone found to be using or selling illegal drugs on the premises will be expelled. Strictly no food in the pool/snooker area. No dogs or other pets are permitted in the club except guide dogs. The management reserve the right to refuse entry and any decision made by the management will be final.

Opening Hours

Monday to Thursday 5pm to 11pm
Friday to Sunday 12noon to 11pm
(Excepting Christmas Day)

Parking/Access

Parking is available at the rear of the building to members using the club. **Parking at the front of the club is only available after 5pm Monday – Saturday and all-day Sunday.** Members should be aware that vehicles may be clamped if left there before these times. Fire exits should be opened only in case of emergency. Entry and exit to the club should be through the front main entrance only.
